



Getty View Trailhead

East side of Sepulveda Boulevard, Los Angeles, California

Located on the east side of the Sepulveda Pass near Getty Center Drive, Getty View Trailhead offers fine views and a challenging hike into more than 300 acres of public open space. A one mile uphill hike leads to a ridgeline fire road, providing outstanding views of the ocean, the Getty Center and the City of Los Angeles. At the fire road, you can proceed either north or south. Turning left to the north, the road continues approximately .25 mile to a private residential area. Turning right to the south, the road continues approximately .5 miles to Casiano Drive. Both directions provide stunning views of Hoag Canyon.

Directions: From the 405 Freeway northbound and southbound, exit Getty Center Drive. Turn left onto Sepulveda Boulevard. The park entrance is located on east side of Sepulveda Boulevard. Parking is available at the trailhead.
