



Augustus F. Hawkins Natural Park

5790 Compton Avenue, Los Angeles, California, 90011

Located at the corner of Compton and Slauson Avenues in South Los Angeles, 8.5-acre Augustus F. Hawkins Natural Park provides a serene natural environment in the urban core of the city. Native plant communities, oak trees, rolling hills, riparian areas, and a running stream mimic a native California setting. A strolling path, picnic and barbeque areas, an outdoor amphitheater, and grassy areas provide local residents and families comfortable gathering places to socialize and relax. Barbeques are available for use with permit.

Directions: From the Harbor Freeway (110), take the Slauson exit, turning east at the end of the off-ramp. Proceed on Slauson Avenue to Compton Avenue. Turn left onto Compton and then immediately turn right into the parking lot.
