



Temescal Gateway Park

15601 Sunset Boulevard, Pacific Palisades, CA 90272

Located in Pacific Palisades, Temescal Gateway Park is one of the most popular parks in the Santa Monica Mountains. The park encompasses 141 acres of oak and sycamore canyons, a waterfall, ridgetop views, and access to miles of trails in Topanga State Park, Will Rogers State Historic Park, and the 20,000-acre "Big Wild."

Directions: Take the Santa Monica Freeway (10) to Pacific Coast Highway (PCH). Continue west on PCH. Turn right (north) on Temescal Canyon Road and continue for a mile. You enter the park immediately after crossing Sunset Boulevard. Fee parking is available for \$10 per day.
