Directions:

Take the Calgrove exit from the Golden State Freeway (Interstate 5). Turn west back under the freeway and take The Old Road south. Parking for Ed Davis Park at Towsley Canyon is .5 miles from the park entrance.

Visit nearby parks:

Pico Canyon: I-5 Exit Lyons Ave. Turn left at stop sign, cross over the freeway, continue straight on Pico Cyn Rd. Bear left at "Y" intersection and continue to end of the road.

Whitney Canyon: I-5 to CA 14 East. Exit Newhall Rd. South, continue one block, park in the Park & Ride.

Wilson Canyon: From the 210 Freeway, take the Roxford exit, turning north to Olive View Drive. Proceed past main hospital and four-way stop at Bledsoe Street. The park entrance road is approx. 200 yards east of Bledsoe, just before Fenton Ave.

East & Rice Canyon: I-5 Exit Calgrove. Turn west and take The Old Road south for 1 mile to park entrance.

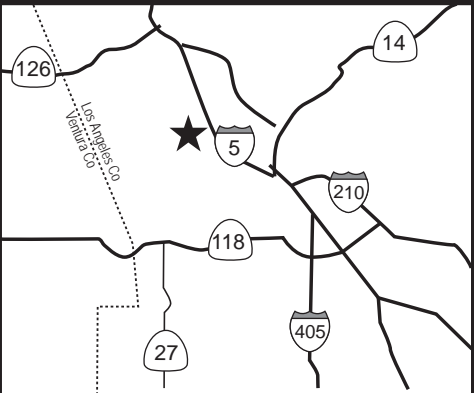
